- Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class.
- For the Silver Salver Trophy - the 10 entries must be nominated by the exhibitor **on the entry form by the closing date. Not on the day.**
- Only one name on the entry per exhibit, unless class or category specifies otherwise.
- Entries must be grown in the Exhibitor's own garden or allotment, (except in the case of Floral Art classes, class nos. 10 and 11 and children's classes, or where specified).
- crafts items - hobbyists only please.
- The Committee shall not be responsible for loss or damage to exhibits.
- Points awarded to class winners are as follows:
1st - 4 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points.
If the judges award an equal place, both exhibitors will receive the full points for that place. Highest number of points in each category wins that category.
- Extra entries in each class can be exhibited marked 'for display only' subject to space available.
- Items cannot be accepted for competition if entered the previous year.
- No late entries accepted on the day.

Flowers and Pot Plants (A)

1. Mixed perennial garden flowers - not more than 10 stems, 3 or more kinds
2. Annuals - 5 different varieties, one stem of each
3. 3 roses of the same variety
4. 3 dahlias - one variety
5. flowering shrub - 1 stem (in flower)
6. Pot plant in a pot (not purchased within last 6 months)
7. Cactus or succulent (indoor plant)
8. 3 stems of any fuschia (same or mixed varieties)

Floral Art (B)

9. A foliage only display, any design
10. An arrangement 'A Whiter Shade of Pale'
11. An arrangement in a tea cup overall size 12"/30cm

Fruit (C)

12. 3 apples, dessert - one variety
13. 3 apples, cooking - one variety
14. 3 plums, one variety
15. collection of fruit - 4 different kinds
16. 1 variety of soft fruit
17. 3 pears

Vegetables (D)

18. 3 vegetables of your own choice
19. Collection of 3 different root vegetables
20. 5 onions - bulbs should be shown without roots, with stems trimmed and tied
21. 3 beetroot with foliage trimmed to approx. 3" / 75mm
22. 3 carrots with foliage -one variety with foliage trimmed to 3" /75mm
23. 3 runner beans, one variety (with some stalk attached)
24. 3 courgettes
25. 3 peppers or chillies (capsicum any colour)

26. Collection of 5 different culinary herbs in a vase (fresh healthy foliage) one stem of each
27. 5 Potatoes on a plate, same variety, named, medium size approx. 6oz/170gm
28. 3 medium Tomatoes, named, approx. 2¼" / 60mm dia. with fresh calyces attached
