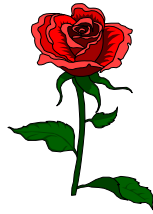

Flower & Produce Show Schedule 2022

Saturday 4th September Open to public at 2.30pm

Flowers & pot Plants (A)

1. Mixed perennial garden flowers - not more than 10 stems, 3 or more kinds

2. Annuals - 5 different varieties, one stem of each
3. 3 roses of the same variety
4. 1 specimen rose
5. 3 dahlias - one variety
6. Flowering shrub - 1 stem (in flower)
7. Pot plant in a pot (not purchased within the last 6 months)
8. Cactus or succulent (indoor plant)
9. 3 stems of any fuschia (same or mixed varieties)

10. Vase of assorted berries, seed heads

Floral Art (B)

11. Foliage only display, any design
12. An Autumn arrangement
13. An arrangement in a basket

Fruit (C)

14. 3 apples, dessert - one variety
15. 3 apples, cooking - one variety
16. 3 plums, one variety
17. Collection of fruit - 4 different kinds
18. 1 variety of soft fruit (5)
19. 3 pears

Vegetables (D)

20. 3 vegetables of your own choice
21. Collection of 3 different root vegetables
22. 5 onions - bulbs should be shown without roots, with stems trimmed and tied
23. 3 beetroot with foliage trimmed to approx. 3" / 75mm
24. 3 carrots - one variety with foliage trimmed to 3" / 75mm
25. 3 runner beans, one variety (with some stalk attached)
26. 3 courgettes
27. 3 peppers or chillies (capsicum any colour)
28. Collection of 5 different culinary herbs in a vase (fresh healthy foliage) one stem of each
29. 5 potatoes on a plate, same variety, named medium size approx. 6oz/170gm
30. 3 medium tomatoes, named, approx. 2¼"/60mm dia. With calyces attached
31. 5 small cultivar tomatoes, named, no more than 1½"/35mm dia. With calyces attached
32. 1 cucumber

Miscellaneous (E)

33. Any misshapen vegetable
34. Largest Bergenia Leaf
35. Longest Runner Bean
36. '**Dingnote Prize**' like the (Turner)/Turnip Prize (that is something simple to do but means something else, (inventive / imaginative / tongue in cheek artwork))

Cakes & Preserves (F)

37. Victoria Sandwich (3 eggs, raspberry jam filling, caster sugar dusting, using tin no larger than 8" / 20cm)
38. 5 muffins
39. Lemon Drizzle cake, provide recipe

40. 5 cheese scones
41. 5 Brownies
42. Savoury Quiche 8-9" / 20-23cm
43. 1 pot of Marmalade (wax disc and cover)
44. 1 pot of Chutney (wax disc and cover)
45. 1 pot of Jam (wax disc and cover)
46. 1 pot of Jelly (wax disc and cover)
47. 1 loaf of bread, or 5 bread rolls, homemade with recipe, (bread maker machine can be used).

Handicrafts (G)

48. An item of needlework
49. Any knitted item (hats, poppies, or an item for the Shoe Box appeal)
50. Handcrafted item in any medium
51. Handcrafted item in metal or wood
52. A cross stitch or embroidered item

Art & Photography (H) Photographs on photographic paper any size

53. A picture, any subject a drawing
54. A picture, any subject a painting
55. A photograph 'Bird/s on your bird feeder'
56. A photograph 'Summer Holidays'
57. A photograph 'Favourite Plant'
58. A photograph 'Butterfly'
59. 3 photos - 'Stunning Shrubs, Tremendous Trees, Fabulous Flowers' (single or multiple in each)

Children's (free entry) (I)

60. 11 and under - a rainbow picture
61. 11 and under - a gingerbread person
62. 11 and under - a vegetable figure or monster
63. 11 and under - a garden on a plate no bigger than 8" / 20cm
64. 11 and under - origami, any design.
65. 11 and under - A Poem, handwritten or typed, own composition on a sheet of A4, decorated.
66. 11 and under - 5 decorated cakes

Edington Under 5's Group (also open to any other Under 5's)

67. Pipe cleaner 'spider'
68. A potato print design

Village Shield Group entry (J) (free entry)

69. Entitled 'Platinum Jubilee'

70. Special Entry

Any plant grown (attempted) for the first time during 'Lockdown'

Edington Gardening Club Show Rules

- Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class.

- For the Silver Salver Trophy - the 10 entries must be nominated by the exhibitor **on the entry form by the closing date. Not on the day.**
- Only one name on the entry per exhibit unless class or category specifies otherwise.
- Entries must be grown in the Exhibitor's own garden or allotment, (Except in the case of Floral Art classes, class nos. 12 and 13 and children's classes, or where specified). Extra marks will be given for own flowers used.
- crafts items - hobbyists only please.
- The Committee shall not be responsible for loss or damage to exhibits.
- Points awarded to class winners are as follows:
1st - 4 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points.
If the judges award an equal place, both exhibitors will receive the full points for that place. Highest number of points in each category wins that category.
- Extra entries in each class can be exhibited marked 'for display only' subject to space available.
- Items cannot be accepted for competition if entered the previous year.
- **No late entries accepted on the day.**
- Items left after 5.00pm will be removed from the Hall
