Parish Council News

Speed Indicator Devices (SID)

Wiltshire Council has recently installed 2 SID mounting poles, one each on Lower Road and Tinhead Road. We now have 5 separate locations in the village for SIDs.

Playfield Land Swap

The Parish Council has now reached the step where we have signed the contract for the land swap. The Three Daggers planning application has been submitted to Wiltshire Council for consideration.

Play Equipment

A representative from Playdale has visited the playfield. He will prepare recommendations for safe siting of play equipment in the future and give prices for new play equipment which we might purchase. In December, another representative visited to discuss the safety report received from ROSPA.

Highway Matters / Footpaths / LHFIG

The council decided that a buff anti-slip coating would be the best solution for the sometimes slippery paving slabs on the footpath on the corner of Monastery Road and Lower Road. There is continued concern about the Crossroads Farm junction and the need for more adequate signage; we have made representations to Wiltshire Council to change the junction priorities from GIVE WAY to STOP. There is also much concern about the classification of the B3098 through the village and the attention given to it's maintenance in the light of the volume and size of vehicles.

Village Website Refresh

We have been working on a new village website with a design team - Creative Xolutions. There has been a delay in fully completing the project as it will become a government domain with a domain name to be approved by the Gov.uk team but it is hoped the new website will go live next month.
